INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS FOR SENDING COMMUNICATION PROPOSALS
FOR THEMATIC SESSION (TS) PROPOSALS

Researchers, teachers and graduate students are eligible to send communication proposals for the Thematic Sessions. Undergraduate students will be able to present their work in the Panel category. Form filling for communication in Thematic Session shall be done from April 16th to May 15th, 2009. The form is available at <http://www.ileel.ufu.br/silel2009>. Proposals and abstracts should be sent only by means of the electronic form. Proposals sent by email will be disregarded. To subscribe, the proponents will select one Thematic Session and indicate their option in the submission form, in its specific field. The selecting process of the proposals will be done by the coordinator of the Thematic Session, who is responsible for approving or refusing the submissions received. The disclosure of the Thematic Sessions composition will be done by the Organizing Committee from June 30th, 2009. The coordinators will present their papers only in their Thematic Session. When the abstract is approved for a Thematic Session, the proponent shall print the bank slip for payment according to the deadlines and fees available at the event website.

There will not be any acceptance of more than one work proposal by proponent. Each proponent must subscribe for only one Thematic Session and wait for the coordinator's evaluation. The presented works shall be published in the event's proceedings according to the instructions to be disclosed in due time.

The communication proposal abstract shall contain:

- a) Title;
- b) Keywords (maximum of five);
- c) Minimum of 250 and maximum of 600 words.
